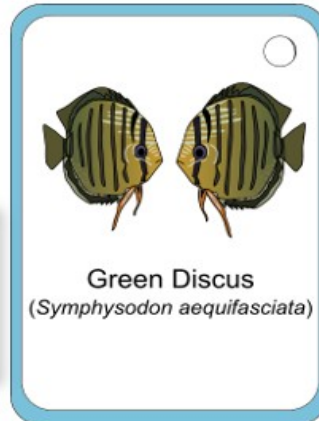
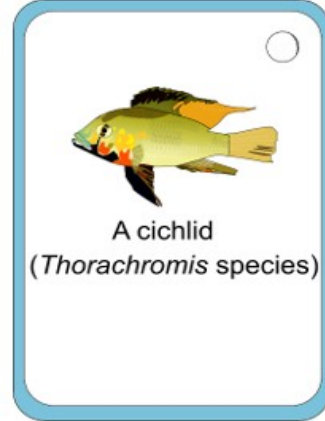
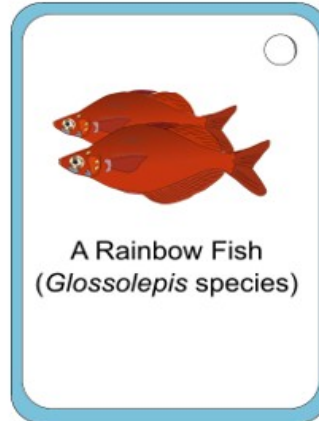


The "Where Do They Come From?" Challenge
